		Key Thought.
	0	If you can't distill the message to one thought, you have a lecture, not a sermon.
	0	If they remember nothing else, what is the thought you want them to walk away with?
	0	Whether you share your main idea at the beginning or the end determines if the
		message is or
		main points that support the main idea.
	0	Every main point must stand on its own.
	0	If it doesn't fit, cut it, or return to the text to see if you're missing something important.
-		sub-points that unpack the main points.

1 (You	ur mai	n point)
	a	: "What does the Bible say?"
	b	: "What does it look like?"
	c	: "What does this mean to me?"
	d	: "Why should I do this?"
